DAY 1

ARRIVAL AND WELCOME AND AURORA FORECASTING

After landing in Ivalo, you'll be transferred to Pine Sky Suites where a warm reception awaits. Once you're settled into your accommodation, you'll be invited to a welcome briefing accompanied by delicious Lappish Tapas. This evening, you'll be taught how to forecast the Aurora Borealis and use your new knowledge on a quest to find them. Hopefully, the Northern Lights will perform a dazzling display of colours and patterns for you to marvel.

DAY 2 SNOWMOBILE SAFARI AND AURORA CAMP WITH SNOWSHOEING & OPEN FIRE DINNER

After a nourishing breakfast, served at a nearby restaurant, you'll head out onto the unspoilt wilderness via snowmobile, an almost ubiquitous way to witness the enchanting scenery and travel like a local. Relish the pristine air and savour the incredible landscapes of Kaunispää, Palopää and Urupää fells. Lunch will be served at Kaunispää.

This evening, your expert guide will build an Aurora camp where they'll prepare an aromatic dinner by the open fire. Look to the sky and anticipate the arrival of the spell-binding Northern Lights. You'll also have the opportunity to explore the magical forest by snowshoe – specialised outdoor footwear that allows you to travel on top of the fresh, powdery snow.

DAY 3

DOG SLEDDING WITH TAÏMYR DOGS AND E-BIKE & ELECTRIC SNOWSCOOTERS

A visit to Finland would be incomplete without a husky safari. Following breakfast at a nearby restaurant, discover the thrill of mushing in this dog sledding activity. The Taïmyr dogs and the Laïka Nenets will be delighted to see you and unlike most breeds, they are known for their minimal barking, creating a more peaceful and relaxed experience.

Today, lunch will be enjoyed in Ivalo before taking a spin on E-Bikes and electric snowscooters – a first of their kind. Your friendly guide will give you a short driving lesson and safety briefing before you set off along the trail. There is also the option to sit in a sledge if you prefer to be chauffeured. This



activity lasts around two hours.

Dinner will be served in Hotel Kultahippu's restaurant in Ivalo. Kultahippu translates to 'gold chip,' epitomising this small treasure in the far north. Expect fantastic hospitality and an extensive menu of delicacies.

DAY 4

SÁMI SIIDA MUSEUM AND WINTER SURVIVAL SKILLS

Enjoy a mouth-watering breakfast at a nearby restaurant before today's exciting programme. Opened to the public in 1963, the Sámi Museum exhibits an open-air museum and collection of pieces with the main purpose to support the identity and cultural self-esteem of the Sámi. This fascinating attraction will give you an insight into the interesting history and culture of the area and its indigenous people.

In the centre of Inari is Čaiju, your lunch stop today. Its name derives from a Skolt Sámi word meaning tea. Offering a variety of organic teas, including the exclusive chaga mushroom latte, sumptuous pastries, handmade sandwiches and savoury treats, Čaiju is a renowned spot.

Your authentic Finnish adventure continues this afternoon with a tutorial in winter survival skills. With an official wilderness guide degree, you can rest assured your instructor will ensure you gain practical, hands-on teaching and equip you with the skills and knowledge for any outdoor exploration.

Following dinner in Kultahippu, there is deliberate space in the itinerary for more Aurora hunting. Hopefully, the Northern Lights will perform a magical display for your final evening.
