What's included?

- **Transfers**: El Prat airport to Barcelona hotel, Barcelona to Sort (please note this transfer is approximately 3 hours) and from Sort back to El Prat airport
- **Accommodation**: 2 nights in a standard double/twin room in a city centre hotel in Barcelona and 4 nights a standard double/twin room in El Pessets Hotel, Sort
- Meals: 6 breakfasts
- In Sort, you can choose to add your own choice of activities from: jeep tour and hike in a national park, white-water rafting, canyoning, via ferrata family route, open kayaking and canopy circuit, horse riding and El Batlliu half day hike. To appreciate Catalonia as a whole though, you need to venture beyond the urban sophistication of Barcelona and take the scenic journey to Sort, in the heart of the Pyrenees. More than just a picturesque medieval town nestling among the mountain peaks, Sort is also an adventure playground. Here you can unleash your sense of adventure and go white-water rafting, canyoning and take on the challenge of a via ferrata or a kayaking and high ropes course day. Or you can simply enjoy the serenity of your surroundings and hike or horse ride through the alpine forests and along the banks of crystal clear rivers and lakes. Sort itself is a charming town to explore and full of the rich cultural heritage of the region. It's narrow cobbled lanes and castle reflect its long history and the impressive Noguera Pallaresa river, one of the best in Europe for water-sports, runs through the town. To top it off, you will also find a wealth of dining options for such a small town. Whether you are looking for tapas, hearty mountain fare to fuel your adventures or to experience fine dining at a Michelin starred restaurant the diverse local dining scene has you covered.

EXPLORE BARCELONA AT YOUR OWN PACE

Barcelona is a city that is on every traveller's must see list. It is home to the striking architecture of Gaudi, the art (and museum) of Picasso together with the enticing appeal of palm trees, beaches and cava and tapas on offer around every corner. The city also boasts a very efficient underground network linking together sights like Sagrada Familia, Casa Batllo and even those further out of the centre like the Camp Nou, so you will be able to see as much (or as little!) as you wish in your time here.

White-Water Rafting

Today you will take to the water for a thrilling morning of white-water rafting; You will be given a full safety briefing and paddling instructions on the river bank prior to boarding your raft. Your expert guide will be at the helm and working in teams of up to eight people you will enjoy the delights of the river together. This is always an activity highlight for families.

You will enjoy between one and one and a half hours of exhilaration on the river.

ACTIVITIES







Canyoning

Canyoning is an unforgettable activity, offering challenges, thrills and delight in equal measure. In groups of around ten people, you head to the top of the canyon (the 30-minute uphill is definitely well rewarded) in order to descend in a variety of ways; heading downstream via a series of slides, jumps, abseils and swims. This area of the Pyrenees is known as a canyoning hotspot and with good reason, these mountains provide the perfect activity playground.

The activity itself lasts for around an hour and a half from

top to bottom.



Forest High Ropes Course and Open Water Kayaking

Visit the Pirineu Natural Park to take part in a high ropes course set in a beautiful alpine forest and overlooking a tranquil lake. The platforms and ropes are between 1.5 and 6 metres from the ground and full safety equipment and guides supervise your participation.

After you have completed your circuit (approximately 45 minutes) you will also be able to explore the lake by taking a kayak out from one of the nearby beaches. Your

guide will teach you the correct paddling technique and you can then explore the lake or simply relax out on the water. There is also a bar at the park where you can take lunch (not included).



Jeep Tour and Hike in National Park

You will be picked up in 4x4 jeeps and driven up into the stunning Aigüestortes National Park – a perfect introduction to the beautiful peaks and lakes of the Pyrenean landscapes and plentiful wildlife such as eagles and crossbills. You will then enjoy a short hike covering approximately six kilometres. Our guides have found a lovely route that offers stunning views of the scenery.





Guided Via Ferrata

If you have not heard of a via ferrata before, they are a network of anchors, cables, rungs and ladders (usually metal – hence the name, iron path) to make traversing steep slopes easier. You will still have all the relevant safety equipment, including a harness to secure yourself to the cable, but under the guide's instruction, it is the confidence that they give you that will get you to viewpoints that might otherwise be out of reach. The whole experience is really a fusion of hiking and climbing. This experience lasts around two hours.



Horse Riding

A 1 hour horse-riding route for all ages on horses that are specially trained for equestrian tourism. The team of professional equestrian guides at nearby Rialp assure you a rewarding, unique and personal experience on horseback surrounded by the best Pyrenean landscapes. The guides will take you through all aspects of safety and basic skills before starting the route. Then, you will follow a scenic local path along the valley by the rushing waters of the Noguera Pallaresa river.



Batlliu Hike

Enjoy a half day hike exploring the surroundings of Sort in the company of a local guide. The route will start at your hotel and you will walk together through the town until reaching the traditional path that links Sort with the villages nearby. During the hike, you will learn about ancient ways of living, visit small mountain villages and enjoy the best views of the Noguera Pallaresa valley.

Hotel in Barcelona City Centre (Nights: 1-2)
