During this seven-night holiday, you'll travel via jeep, on foot and during a boat journey to reach exceptional lookout points and find amazing marine life. Don't worry though, there will still be plenty of time for you to sample the local wines too!

## What's included?

- **Transfers:** all transfers included
- **Accommodation:** 7 nights' hotel accommodation in double/twin rooms\*
- **Meals:** 7 breakfasts
- **The following activities are included in the holiday:** Full day walking tour – Queimadas Levada and Laurisilva Wood, Whale and Dolphin Watching\*\*, Full daywalking tour – Rabacal Levada, Jeep tour to northwest of the island, Full day walking tour – Larano and the north coast (the order of activities is subject to change)
- Fully qualified guides and instructors during activities

\* Hotels in Madeira now charge a tourist tax of 2 euros/per person per night (up to maximum of 7 nights) this must be paid locally on check in. Children up to 13 years will be exempt.

\*\* It may be possible to snorkel alongside the boat with the dolphins if the conditions are right, please note local animal welfare legislation requires you to keep a hand on the boat at all times. There is also the possibility that not all the members of the group will be able to do it before the dolphins move on. There is an additional €20pp charge to be paid locally to the activity provider on the day if you wish to enter the water with the dolphins.

## Trip Overview

**Whilst we have preferred hotel options for our Madeira itineraries, the pressure on hotel rooms on this charming and popular islands means that on rare occasions we may make alternative hotel suggestions. These suggestions are themselves carefully chosen to ensure there will be minimal impact on the operation of your itinerary.**

Your week of discovery on Madeira begins with an exploration of it's lush interior - a Levada walk through ancient laurel forests, complete with waterfalls and ancient tunnels through the rock now overgrown with foliage of the deepest green. It is like walking through the land that time forgot! You will also have a free day to spend as you wish – you can relax at your hotel or make the most of Funchal which has offers attractions as diverse as the Botanical Gardens, a cable car and the Cristiano Ronaldo museum!

A trip to these Atlantic islands would not be complete without heading out to sea for some whale and dolphin watching. The Gulf Stream makes Madeira a hotspot for many cetacean species, and the manoeuvrable RIB boats allow a fantastic way to get as close as possible to them without disrupting their natural behaviour.

The second of your Levada hikes explores Rabaçal and its stunning waterfalls and the magical 25 Fountains Lagoon, but you will also be able to rest your legs when you experience Madeira's wild side in the comfort of a jeep. You will take to the island's smaller roads and off-road trails (these can get pretty bumpy!) for some breathtaking views, including the unique lava pools of Porto Moniz. For your final Levada walk, you will hike the Larano trail, an old trade route with stunning cliffside views and glimpses of the island of Porto Santo.

Your week will offer a fantastic mix of nature, adventure, and relaxation.

DAY 1	ARRIVAL
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Your transfer will meet you at the airport and take you to your chosen hotel so you can settle in and get ready for your week of exploring the trails of Madeira.

DAY 2	FULL DAY WALKING TOUR – QUEIMADAS LEVADA AND LAURISILVA WOOD
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Today's Levada walk takes you through some of Madeira's most remote and splendid scenery and you

will develop an appreciation for the emerald green landscape of the island's interior.

You will follow the Caldeirão Verde Levada, as it winds through ancient laurel forests. The sound of bubbling water will accompany you through the day and if you keep an eye on the waters you may even spot some wild trout!

Another highlight are the frequent tunnels along the route, which are a spectacle themselves. Your hike will end at an amazing waterfall – perfect for a rest and some photos.

WHALE AND DOLPHIN WATCHING

Thanks to the Gulf Stream, there are whales and dolphins off the coast of Madeira all year round.

Making use of a manoeuvrable RIB (max. 12-16 people) your captain, working in tandem with onshore scouts, will do their utmost to locate pods of dolphins and whales.

With luck, you might even have the opportunity to snorkel with dolphins (additional costs apply – to be paid locally).

We do like to stress to our guests that the welfare of the animals is the primary consideration in this activity, so there are no guarantees of sightings or durations and they decide how long they want to stay in the area of the boat and are not pursued in any way. However from our personal experience of this activity, you will have plenty of opportunity to capture some fantastic memories and photographs.

FULL DAY WALKING TOUR - RABAÇAL LEVADA WALK

The full-day Rabaçal Levada walk again immerses you deep in the heart of Madeira's UNESCO World Heritage Laurel forests.

You will follow the gravity defying Levada system over stone bridges and past cascading waterfalls. These range from delicate trickles to powerful torrents and are interspersed with dense growths of trees and moss-covered tunnels carved into the rock.

Highlights of this route include the serene Lagoa das 25 Fontes (25 Fountains Lagoon) and the majestic Risco Waterfall.

### THE NORTHWEST JEEP TOUR (FULL DAY)

Breathtaking views are guaranteed on this tour, as you travel on Madeira's old roads (and even off-road) in search of the island's most stunning destinations.

The Northwest is famous for its dramatic cliffs overlooking the Atlantic, as well as lush green valleys and Laurissilva forest of the interior.

Highlights of the tour are the elevated Paul da Serra plateau with its otherworldly scenery and Porto Moniz where it is possible to bathe in the lava pools formed along the coast.

### NORTHCOAST "LARANO" HIKE (FULL DAY)

There are few coastal walks in Europe that are as diverse as the Larano.

Hundreds of years ago this path was created for trade to get from Porto da Cruz to Machico. Nowadays, this walking route enchants visitors with its beautiful views, whether in the Machico valley, in the cliffs over the sea to the neighbouring Island of Porto Santo or in the fishing village of Santa Cruz.

## Canyoning

In a beautiful valley in rural Madeira, lies a hidden green canyon. During this activity, you won't just discover the canyon, you will travel through it as you follow the water on its journey downstream.

Canyoning is a safe, yet adventurous activity that allows you to travel in the direction of the water as it makes its way through the picturesque canyon. On your journey, you'll come across four different rappels varying in altitude up to 17 metres. There's also two small slides and two small jumps (optional).

## Half Day Kayaking and Snorkelling

There's no better way to appreciate the coastal waters of Madeira than to get out onto it.

Using a sit-on-top kayak, you'll paddle out to the Underwater Nature Reserve of Garajau. Established in 1986, this reserve is full of marine life including large fish and manta rays. You'll hopefully see the different species as you kayak along the water but you'll also have plenty of time to snorkel and enjoy the underwater sights too.

### Castanheiro Boutique Hotel (Nights: 1-7)



The Castanheiro Boutique Hotel is situated in Funchal's fascinating Old Town, next to the Palace of Jesuits and only steps away from a host of wonderful local restaurants, cafés and shops.
