Norway's natural beauty is unparalleled, with majestic fjords, towering mountains, and cascading waterfalls seemingly at every turn. What better way to discover this country of wonder than with you in the driver's seat and on the open road through the rolling countryside.

Your self-drive journey begins in Bergen, a charming city surrounded by stunning fjords and unique architecture. You'll have time at the beginning and end of your holiday to explore the city and soak up its cultural delights.

From Bergen, you'll make your way to Flåm where the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Nærøyfjord awaits. Here, you'll check into your peaceful hotel for two nights to give you plenty of time for optional activities in the area. We recommend the Flåm Zipline for an adrenaline-fuelled way to be amongst the towering mountains. You could also embark on a scenic fjord cruise through Nærøyfjord to get close to the natural wonders and wildlife in the area.

Next on the fjord bucket-list is Sognefjord - Norway's longest and deepest fjord. Then it's onto

UNESCO-listed Geiranger Fjord, where you can opt for a thrilling RIB safari or a serene kayaking tour to get out onto the invitingly-blue waters.

As you make your way back to Bergen, you can stop in peaceful villages and enjoy the scenic ferry crossings before savouring the city's attractions - from the historic Bryggen Wharf to the bustling fish market.

This fjord-filled self-drive holiday has been carefully crafted to ensure you see the best of Norway, but in your own time and done your way. DAY
2

SELF DRIVE BERGEN - FLÅM (2.5 HOURS)

Following breakfast at the hotel, you'll take to the open road to see the spectacular scenery Norway has on offer.

Driving out of Bergen, you'll leave the city behind and become immersed in the natural wonders of the region. Along the way, you'll see the village of Gudvangen where the road intersects with Nærøfjord. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is one of the narrowest fjords in the country, with plunging cliffs and deep blue waters.

As you arrive in the charming village of Flåm, you'll be greeted by the tranquillity of the Aurlandsfjord on one side and the majestic mountains on the other for a truly Norwegian welcome.

You'll check into the Flåmsbrygga Hotel which is ideally situated at the Flåm harbour with incredible views of the fjord. These quiet and peaceful surroundings will help you totally unwind whilst still being close to all transport routes, shops, and restaurants where you could go to enjoy dinner this evening.

DAY IN FLÅM AND OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

Today, following breakfast in the hotel you have a free day to explore Flåm. We recommend taking on a ziplining adventure or a fjord cruise to immerse yourself in the stunning landscape.

Zipline

The Flåm Zipline is Scandinavia's longest zipline, offering a thrilling experience in the Flåm Valley. You'll take the famed Flåm Railway journey, a beautiful train ride that takes you high up into the mountains and is an unmissable experience all in itself. You'll arrive at Vatnahalsen station and then proceed to the zipline's starting point, just a few minutes away. Breathtaking views await you as you zoom through the mountains. Please note that there are weight and health restrictions for this activity.

To add to your adventure, you could take a bike up with you to ride down after the zipline experience. In Kårdalen there are a limited number of bikes for rent.

Nærøfjord Fjord Cruise

To really experience the beauty of the fjords, you can take a cruise on the Nærøfjord. On board, you'll find a top deck to see the beautiful waters, towering mountains, and tumbling waterfalls - out here, it won't be long until you see why this is a world heritage site. Make sure you keep an eye out for the seals, porpoises, and eagles in the area! Inside you will find Nordic-inspired interior design offering a high level of comfort.

RIB FjordSafari in Nærøfjorden

On this exciting RIB tour, you'll speed through the Aurlandsfjord and to the entrance of the spectacular Nærøfjord. You'll see Sagfossen, a breathtaking waterfall in the heart of the World Heritage site, where you'll have a beautiful view of Nærøfjord.

The RIB boats only holds a maximum of 12 guests, ensuring a personal experience with our guides and a chance to get close to small villages and waterfalls along the way. Enjoy the scenery, stories, and history shared by your personal guide. We take you closer to nature and try spot seals, porpoises, and eagles along the way.

DAY
4

DRIVE FLÅM - BESTEBAKKEN (APPROX 2 HOURS)

After breakfast, say farewell to Flåm and set off on your self-drive journey to the Bestebakken Hotel.

Along the way, you'll pass through charming villages like Aurlandsvangen and Sogndal. Don't miss the opportunity to visit the Stegastein viewpoint and admire the stunning Sognefjord, Norway's longest and deepest fjord.

As you approach Hafslo, the Bestebakken Hotel will greet you with its panoramic views and cosy accommodation. Tonight, we recommend relaxing in the hotel's outdoor jacuzzi before enjoying a

delectable dinner in the onsite restaurant (not included.)

DAY
5

DRIVE BESTEBAKKEN - GEIRANGER (APPROX 5 HOURS)

Following breakfast, you'll check out from BesteBakken and begin your drive to Geiranger.

Along the way, you'll reach the town of Sogndal, where you can take a break and explore the local attractions, such as the Sogn Fjord Museum or the Fosshaugane Campus Park. Further along, you'll arrive in Skei, where you can stop and explore the local attractions, such as the Breheimsenteret Glacier Center or the Jølstravatnet Lake.

From Hellesylt, you'll take the ferry across the Geirangerfjord to the town of Geiranger, which is surrounded by jaw-dropping natural beauty.

Here, you'll check into the Grande Fjord Hotel, located in the heart of Geiranger and just 100 metres from the World Heritage Geiranger Fjord. This modern hotel is located 2km from the centre of Geiranger with a private shuttle to take you into town.

6

DAY IN GEIRANGER

Today, following breakfast in the hotel, you'll have the day to soak up the sights of Geiranger.

We recommend taking the RIB Safari into the Geirangerfjord for spectacular views of the famous waterfalls Seven Sisters, the Friar, and the Bridal Veil. With knowledgeable guides, you'll hear local stories as you cut between the steep mountains and feel the sea spray.

If you want to spend more time on the water, you could opt for the discover kayaking tour for an even closer experience of the fjord. This is the perfect introduction to kayaking as you enjoy a gentle paddle with an experienced guide. Starting at the harbour, you'll paddle down the fjord and toward the Seven Sister waterfall. Make sure you bring a camera for this unique view right from your kayak.

DAY
7

SELF DRIVE GEIRANGER - JØLSTER (APPROX 4 HOURS)

Following breakfast, you'll check out of your hotel and start your journey to Jølster.

You'll get back on the scenic ferry ride back to the charming village of Hellesylt. Upon arrival, you'll continue your drive along the National Tourist Route where you'll navigate hairpin bends and be

rewarded with panoramic vistas of deep valleys, glistening lakes, and majestic peaks.

Finally, you'll arrive in the welcoming village of Jølster, nestled amidst the breathtaking Jølster Valley. The road leads you directly into the village, where you can relax and revel in the peaceful ambiance of this scenic region. We recommend going to the Jølstramuseum to soak up the culture, art, and exquisite local food.

You'll check into your hotel with its warm and welcoming atmosphere and in the perfect location to admire the surrounding mountains and lakes. Tonight, we recommend unwinding in the hotel's wellness facilities.

SELF DRIVE: JØLSTER - BERGEN (APPROX 3 HOURS)

Following breakfast in the hotel, you'll check out and leave the village of Jølster to make your way towards Førde, with views of the shimmering lakes and verdant landscapes that surround you.

We recommend stopping here to explore the town's cultural offerings, visit local museums, and soak up the lively atmosphere. Førde is known for its rich history and artistic heritage, offering a glimpse into the region's cultural scene.

From Førde, the road leads you towards Lavik, where you'll catch the Lavik-Oppedal ferry for a stunning journey across the Sognefjord.

Arriving at Oppedal, you'll continue your drive to Bergen. This lively coastal city offers a wealth of attractions to explore, including the historic UNESCO-listed Bryggen Wharf, the vibrant Fish Market, and the picturesque waterfront area - and your hotel puts you in the heart of it all.

Spend some time wandering through the city's narrow streets, visit museums that showcase Bergen's maritime heritage, the aquarium and indulge in the local cuisine, which features a delightful array of seafood specialties.

Clarion Havnekontoret (Nights: 1,8)



The Havenekontoret Hotel is a historic hotel located in the heart of Bergen, close to many of the city's top attractions, including Bryggen, the fish market, and the Fløibanen funicular which is featured on your itinerary. The hotel occupies a beautiful 18th-century building that has been carefully restored and renovated to offer modern amenities and comfortable accommodations.

The hotel has 45 rooms, all of which are individually decorated and feature unique design elements that reflect the building's history and character. The rooms are all ensuite and equipped with amenities such as coffee makers, free Wi-Fi, flat-screen TVs, and hair dryers.

The Havenekontoret Hotel also features a restaurant and bar, which serves a range of traditional Norwegian dishes and international cuisine. Guests will enjoy a complimentary breakfast and evening buffet each day.

Parking is available at the Havnekontoret but must be paid for locally at the hotel itself.

Flåmsbrygga Hotel (Nights: 2-3)



Ideally situated at the Flåm harbour, the Flåmsbrygga Hotel is a wonderful base close to local shops and restaurants in a peaceful setting with fantastic fjord views.

The hotel is a cluster of buildings featuring Norwegian pinewood panelling to offer a traditional and rustic style yet with a modern feel.

BesteBakken (Nights: 4)

This charming boutique hotel has a rich tradition as a former mountain farm and exudes a sense of history as well as a welcoming and cosy atmosphere. It's a place where adventure, culture, and good food meet – all against the fantastic backdrop of the Hafslo Valley and Sognefjord.

The hotel offers a variety of amenities, including a restaurant, bar, sauna, and outdoor hot tub. The restaurant serves traditional Norwegian cuisine made with

locally sourced ingredients. The bar offers a wide selection of beers, wines, and cocktails.
