In Brief

Experience the perfect mix of Norway's natural scenery with buzzing city culture during this four-night stay. You will spend two nights in the heart of Tromsø and another two on the peaceful island of Sommarøy with a Polar fjord cruise and Midnight Sun cruise to enhance your stay.











What's included?

- Transfers: return airport transfers and transfer to Sommarøy
- Accommodation: 2 nights at Clarion Hotel The Edge in a standard double/twin room, 2 nights at the Sommarøy Arctic Hotel in a standard double/twin room
- Meals: 4 breakfasts, 2 lunches, 2 dinners
- The following activities are included in the holiday: Polar fjord cruise, Midnight Sun cruise* (the order of activities is subject to change)
- Fully qualified guides and instructors during activities

*Please note: the Midnight Sun is visible in Tromsø between 22nd May – 22nd July (approximately), outside of these dates you will enjoy a sunset sailing experience

Trip Overview

Northern Norway is not your typical summer destination but when you consider the highlights on this trip - white sandy beaches on a remote island, sailing tours across fjords, local cuisine and culture - then being out of the norm is most definitely not a bad thing. What's more, when you consider that from mid- May until the end of July (c.22nd May-22nd July), this area is washed in the 24-hour glow of the Midnight Sun, we can't think of a better time to visit this spectacular destination.

This four-night trip gives you an excellent mix of buzzing city life with quaint coastal villages, offering you the chance to experience the real Norwegian highlights. You'll start in Tromso, known affectionately as the 'Paris of the North' or the 'Gateway to the Arctic', with each nickname becoming abundantly clear when you set foot here. With its vibrant selection of restaurants and museums and surrounded by spectacular nature, your time in Tromsø will allow you to experience both. You'll have plenty of free time to explore the city and the included activities of the Polar fjord cruise and Midnight Sun/Sunset sailing cruise are the perfect opportunity to get up close to the fjords and your breathtaking natural surroundings.

The second half of your trip takes place in Sommaroy, known fondly as 'Summer Island'. With clear blue waters and white sandy beaches, this peaceful location is a sublime place to stroll around and explore. Your hotel overlooking the Atlantic Ocean also provides a wonderfully scenic backdrop for





your included three-course Arctic dining experiences.

With long daylight hours, jaw-dropping scenery, and exciting activities, this four-night stay is your chance to turn a typical summer holiday on its head for an unforgettable trip.

DAY 1

ARRIVAL AND WELCOME

Following your arrival at Tromsø Airport, you will be transferred 15 minutes to your hotel in the city.

You'll be staying within easy walking distance of Tromsø's many restaurants where you could try some of the local dishes.

Please note: the order of activities will be confirmed in your final travel documents and the order shown here is for illustrative purposes.

DAY 2

POLAR FJORD CRUISE AND MIDNIGHT SUN/SUNSET CRUISE

Following breakfast, you will experience genuine Arctic wildlife such as sea eagles on a cruise through the magnificent fjords that surround Tromsø. You will leave Tromso behind and soon be in picture postcard scenery, while a selection of snacks are provided (including fresh fish) as you. This is the perfect combination of adventure and comfort as your vessel has a warm cabin if required but you can also stay on deck to admire the unmissable views.

Your crew will feature experienced fishermen from the area and these local "pirates" will tell you old tales and traditions that their ancestors have passed on through generations. If you wish you will even get the opportunity to fish and sample the catch!

This tour last approximately 4-5 hours.

Back on land, you'll have the rest of the afternoon free to do as you please before your sailing excursion this evening.





Tonight, the tour will start at a nearby location where it's time to make the most of the glorious golden sunlight that bathes the surrounding nature during a stunning cruise. You'll set off at 9 pm so if you're visiting May-July you'll still have an abundance of sunlight thanks to the Midnight Sun (c.22nd May-22nd July). If you're travelling outside these months, you'll get to experience the golden hour and watch the sunset (weather permitting).

This peaceful time of the evening makes perfect viewing for nature and wildlife in the fjords that surround Tromsø. Hot drinks and snacks are available for purchase during the cruise.

DAY 3

TRANSFER TO SOMMARØY

Today, following breakfast, it's time to check out of your hotel and head to Sommarøy, just over an hour away. The bus journey allows you to see more of Norway's beautiful landscape as you make your way into the traditional fishing community of Sommarøy.

Your hotel overlooks the Atlantic Ocean, right in the heart of this remote, yet thriving coastal community.

Enjoy lunch in the hotel in a beautiful setting, situated by the sea and serving food from the Arctic. Afterwards, why not take a stroll around the island – you can circumnavigate this little gem and its famed white sand beaches in about an hour, but please take your camera and allow time to take some picture of your stunning surroundings.

This evening, dinner will be served in the hotel.

DAY 4

FREE DAY

Today, following breakfast, you'll have the day free to yourself to explore Sommarøy. Wander around the coastal path or take one of the many hiking paths to get up close to the beautiful nature. Alternatively, you might want to enjoy one of the many optional activities, such as sea kayaking, a boating tour of the islands, or a hiking tour of the surrounding hills – please see our personalise tab for full details.

Tonight, another three-course Arctic dinner will be served in the restaurant at the hotel so you can enjoy your final night peacefully by the water.

Sommarøy – Midnight Sun kayaking

What better way to experience the Midnight Sun than by kayak. Glide through the calm still waters and keep your eyes open for any whale sightings along the way. You will also be able to view seals and sea eagles within their own environment. All of this along with an instructor, equipment and an experience you will never forget.

This is a unique version of the daytime kayak expedition, taking place in the light summer evenings with the advantage of the Midnight Sun to show nature at its very best.



Hike and Boat Evening Tour

During this tour, you'll visit Håja, a small and uninhabited island accessible only by boat. You'll be able to spot the island by its distinguishable grassy hilltop rising dramatically from the sea. It truly does like something from an epic adventure film set.

After anchoring up, get ready to head to the summit on foot. The terrain begins with a steep uphill climb and then eases into a gentle slope, but the initial effort is absolutely worth it for the panoramic views of the surrounding islands and fjords at the top.

Following the descent, you'll head back to Sommarøy whilst watching out for the local wildlife as the sun brushes the horizon.*

*The Midnight Sun occurs between 22nd May to 22nd July (approximately), when the sun does not drop below the horizon. If you are travelling outside of this time, whilst it will still be light during the tour, the sun will be setting as you return to land.

Sea Kayaking

Get into nature as you discover the surrounding areas of Sommarøy by kayak. Suitable for all abilities, you'll be given full instruction by your expert guide before heading out to sea.

Marvel at the impressive landscape as you glide through the treasure trove of islets on the hunt for hidden beaches. Closer to the shoreline, you'll see the reef through crystal clear waters and potentially spot maritime wildlife.

You'll get the chance to go ashore and explore one of the islands, where your guide will discuss the local flora and fauna and share their in-depth knowledge of the coastal community and the region of Sommarøy.

Sommaroy - Sea Eagle Safari

With a wingspan of over 2 metres, viewing a sea eagle up close will be an unforgettable part of any stay on Sommaroy. The island is host to a sizeable colony of these majestic birds year round, but they are best seen in the summer months, with maximum daylight on your side and a heated boat and guide at your disposal.

Your guide will even throw fish for the eagles who will snatch them out the air with the sharp vision and even sharper talons, providing a close up look at them in action.
